Who we are.

- The Northern Parish Crime & Safety Forum involves representatives from Parish Councils, Neighbourhood Watch, the local Police and the HBBC Crime & Safety Partnership on behalf of Groby, Field Head, Markfield, Ratby, and Stanton-under-Bardon residents.
- We want to take shared and collective responsibility for crime and safety issues and do not expect these to be seen as the sole responsibility of the Police or the councils;
- We want to promote an approach which recognises that we all have a role to play to support one another and find ways of tackling crime concerns together.

What we do.

The forum was set up to:

- Identify crime and safety issues which are affecting parishes;
- Share ideas and agree consistent ways of tackling these issues across the area;
- Bring Police, Parish, Borough Council, and County Council representatives and members of the community together to understand each other's issues and find ways in which we can help and support each other;
- Share information and knowledge of services and resources which exist or are planned to help deal with crime and anti-social behaviour;

- Raise issues from the public received by Parish Councils about the response of the Police to reported crime and receive feedback from the Police on follow up actions they have taken.

Issues which are currently seen as being priority concerns are:

- Nuisance behaviour by some groups of teenagers and young people;
- Fear of anti-social behaviour;
- Apathy towards reporting low level crime to the Police;
- Lack of suitable activities and facilities for young people in some villages.

What we hope to do.

- The forum wants to be a group that finds constructive responses to shared difficulties and concerns. We don't want to be seen as just a 'talking shop'.
- Identify any available funding which we can use to support activities that are trying to improve the quality of life for our communities.
- Provide constructive alternatives to nuisance behaviour and crime.
- We also want to encourage members of the public to report all crime, nuisance and suspicious behaviour to the Police. This will enable us to have a true picture of what is happening in our villages and will influence where policing and other resources are directed in the future.

- It is important that a crime and incident number is obtained for every reported incident.
- Review our terms of reference when appropriate and at least annually to ensure that they are still relevant.
